

Student Orientation

First Broadcast Day, Wednesday. On Tuesday the students should get an orientation on the ITV room, a copy of the student policy, know where to pick up documents and where to hand in documents.

- * Hand out student policy, both student and their parent/guardian need to sign.
- * Hand out student hint List.
- * Review mixers, outgoing, incoming, students only need to adjust incoming audio on the LCD screen.
- * Who is watching? Local principal, remote students, ITV director, people on the network you can't see, and people outside of our network.
- * Students must sit in Camera view, if not you will be counted as absent and can be kicked out of class for repeated incidences.
- * Anyone caught cheating or vandalizing the equipment will be kicked out of class and could be asked to pay back any costs.
- * The originating sites Teacher's rules take precedence over local rules. It is their class.
- * If you cant see or hear the teacher, you must get someone from the office to help you immediately, no one may know but you.

Taking an ITV Class is a privilege, students must be motivated and responsible. There might be down time, but people will still be watching you. Each student is responsible for their class, papers, books and grades.
